FINANCIAL CONCERNS

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT REQUIREMENTS FOR OUR COMING, *but are shared to simply let you know what others are doing. However you choose to take care of us financially, we will trust God and gratefully accept it.*

Some churches take care of the financial needs of a visiting speaker by giving them an *honorarium*, i.e., a previously decided amount from a general budget. Others receive *love offerings*, i.e., collections received at the time a guest ministers. Still others give a visiting speaker or singer a *combination* of the honorarium plus the love offering.

After more than 34 years in full time evangelism, I have found the *third method to be the most common and helpful* in allowing the church to take part in blessing the visiting minister. This evangelist does not choose churches on the basis of size or affluence. Consequently, when love offerings alone are used, they vary considerably. When honorariums alone are used, members and visitors do not have a chance to give *when they have been touched* by the Holy Spirit. In fact, I have had visitors come to my CD table on multiple occasions wondering why they did not have an opportunity to give. Therefore, it seems to work best that the collection (1Corinthians 16:1) be taken in *each service* in which I minister. (Philippians 4:17, III John 5-6). If a church waits until Sunday evening or Monday evening (in regard to a multi-day meeting) to start receiving the love offerings, many of the people will not be there to give.

Another way churches have been a blessing through the years is by reimbursing the travel expenses separate from and in addition to the love offering. The current IRS standard mileage rate for reimbursement is \$0.54 per mile.
