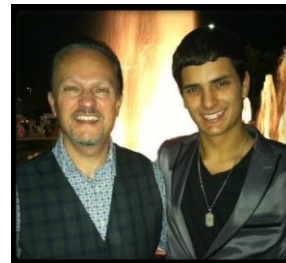

MINISTRY IN MANILA

We had an unexpected opportunity to invite Reuel Tica and his family to our home in Connersville for lunch in June. Reuel is the pastor of the Hillcrest Family Life Baptist Church in Quezon City in Metro Manila, Philippines. He, his wife Christine, and their daughters Debbie and Denise, work with seemingly endless energy and creativity to minister to the people of Manila and throughout the Philippines. The gospel is proclaimed every day as they conduct nightly "Church on the Street," in addition to their regular Sunday services and numerous outreaches. As we continue to plan a return trip to Manila December 18, 2014 - January 1, 2015, we are looking forward to working with Reuel and his church once again. A few of the activities we will be involved in are: Sunday services in various churches, nightly church on the street, an annual street party attended by at least 2,000 people, children's cancer hospital, sport's ministry, concerts, an annual Family Camp, etc. We know from experience that Reuel will make sure we are busy every day!

Our plans are to take a team of six to eight people, including our three sons Alex, Anthony, and Andrew. The current cost for each one is \$2800. **We would like to ask each of you to prayerfully consider investing in this opportunity to reach hundreds of Filipino people with the message that salvation is not found in religion and tradition, but in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. It would also be an investment in the lives of the team members as a trip such as this one is a life-changing experience on many different levels.
